Community leadership can be demonstrated through activities that promote racial and social inclusion, drive reconciliation, encourage environmental stewardship, support and empower Winnipeg's less fortunate, along with many other activities and initiatives that make Winnipeg a place we are all proud to call home.

The scholarships will be presented by Mayor Brian Bowman at City Hall.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE:

- o High school graduates with a minimum overall grade average of 70%
- o Those entering their first year in post-secondary education on a full-time basis at a recognized college or university in the City of Winnipeg
- o Those who have made a significant contribution to Winnipeg and demonstrated outstanding community leadership

Applications must be submitted using the application form enclosed and include three letters of reference to ensure it is considered by the selection panel. Please be sure to include accurate contact information for yourself and references as this information will be used for official correspondence.
